The aim of the Indian Panorama, which is organized by the Directorate of Film Festivals, Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, is to select feature and non-feature films of thematic relevance and aesthetic excellence. The Panorama aims to promote pan-Indian achievements in cinema through festivals and cultural exchanges both in India and abroad.

Juries comprising experts have selected the feature and non-feature films. The line-up of films represents the breadth of filmmaking in India, from student films from the Film and Television Institutes of India to the winners of Best Feature and Best Non-Feature films at the Indian National Film Awards as well as a selection of mainstream cinema.

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3 IDIOTS

2009 | Hindi | 170 min

SYNOPSIS

Farhan, Raju and Rancho are roommates and friends in an engineering college. The film revolves around Farhan and Raju's search for the irrepressible free-thinker Rancho, who vanishes one fine day. During the quest, they recall their shared experiences, such as a long-forgotten bet, a wedding they must crash, and a funeral that goes out of control. But most of all, it is Rancho and his disappearance that intrigues them. Rancho had inspired them to think creatively and independently, even as the conformist world called them "idiots". In the garb of a laugh riot, the film discusses one of the most important of human pursuits, self-actualization.

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

A graduate from the Film and Television Institute of India, Hirani is best known as the creator of the *Munnabhai* film series. He started his career as a film editor in Mumbai and gradually established himself as a director and producer of advertising films. His second film, *Lage Raho Munna Bhai* also won the National Award, 2006.

SYNOPSIS

Acclaimed Bengali filmmaker Aniket is happily married to Deepti, an actress. Together with their son, Apratim, they paint the picture of a perfect family until a young actress Shikha enters their lives.

Shikha is cast for a leading role in Aniket's film. Deepti, enthusiastic about Aniket's project, begins to coach the young actress. Trained to perfection by Deepti, Shikha starts reminding Aniket of young Deepti and the director eventually falls in love with a girl his son's age.

A scandal of cinematic proportions touches their perfect lives. Deepti swears revenge and begins to shape Apratim's career, vowing to turn him into a filmmaker to rival his father.

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

A contemporary director, Rituparno's playground is the complexity of raw human emotions that are often caught in the web of relationships.

He worked in advertising before moving into cinema. He debuted with *Hirer Angti* (1992). However, it was his second film *Unishe April* (National Film Award, 1995) that set the ball rolling. ACHIN PAKHI

2010 | Bengali | 118 min

SYNOPSIS

In a tranquil, rural part of Bengal, Rai Saheb lives with his wife Mita and mentally challenged son Tanu. He also has an obedient servant named Achin, whom he has brought up since childhood.

One day disaster strikes when Tanu kills a maidservant of the house in the middle of the night. In order to save his son from the police, Rai Saheb connives with his wife to send Achin away to a remote island. He tells the police that Achin killed the maid and fled.

During his stay on the island, Achin falls in love with a girl from a fishing community named Pakhi. Even as love blossoms between the two, peril lurks in the shadows. On one of his visits to Achin, Rai Saheb sees Pakhi and decides that she is the right bride for his son.

Achin chooses love rather than sacrifice for his master.

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

A twice-over national film award winner, Anjan Das began his film career in the mid 70's with two documentaries named *The Art of Anant Malakar* and *Tripura*. His first feature was *Sainik*. The film was shown in various international film festivals including Berlin in 1976. Thereafter, several documentaries followed, including documentaries for national and multi-national companies.

In 2001, he made the feature film *Saanjhbatir Rupkathara* (Strokes and Silhouettes), which was distributed by Columbia Tristar. The film was also screened in several film festivals including London, Rome, Rotterdam, Edmonton, Madrid, Singapore etc.

AIDU ONDALA AIDU

2010 | Kannada | 130 min

SYNOPSIS

The film tells the story of a man who dreams of directing a film, and the struggle he undergoes to realize his dream. The protagonist has four short stories that he intends to adapt for the screen-

Sweet Dish: A comedy about a newly wed couple whose lack of communication is highlighted in a humorous manner. The wife incessantly cooks the dessert 'Payasa' for her husband, assuming that he likes it. The husband in turn consumes the 'Payasa', thinking he should not disappoint his new wife.

Mirror Image: A comedy of errors, where a mirror creates much confusion when it gets into the hands of a husband and wife who have never looked into a mirror before.

Dramatic: A journalist interviews a film actor during the course of which the disturbed relationship between a veteran director and his wife is unraveled.

Leaking House: A lazy husband is forced by his wife to take up an odd job. Because of this odd job, the old spark in their relationship is reignited.

Award for Best Debut Director, the John Abraham Award at the Atlantic City Film Festival. His second film, *Freaky Chakra* (2003), an offbeat love story, won the FIPRESCI Jury Award. In 2008, Prakash made *Phir Kabhi*, a Hindi film about the changing meaning of love across different generations. The film won the Los Angeles Reel Film Festival Jury Award. *Gulumaal* (2009), about a day in the lives of two con-men, was a critical and a commercial hit.



SYNOPSIS

Aadu, a Hindu Brahmin girl, falls in love with Suleman, a Muslim. Suleman gifts Aadu an audio recorder that becomes her all-time companion. Soon after their marriage, Suleman leaves for Iraq with two friends to earn a living. Once on the eve of his departure, Suleman stealthily records the sound of their love-making and takes the cassette with him. The war in Iraq breaks out after Suleman reaches there, and Aadu receives no news of him. After seven months of silence, Suleman's friend Jabbar comes back with an audio cassette.

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

Aami Aadu is Somnath Gupta's first film. He has previously worked as a media consultant and workshop facilitator. He has written and directed plays as well as made documentaries. His film output includes the documentaries String Puppets of Nadia, Bhasa Mandakini and India 24 Hours, the telefilms, Chithi Paoar Por and Byatikrom, and two short films, Madhurmani and Three Housewives.

PRODUCER'S PROFILE

New Theatres was founded in 1931 by B.N. Sircar. It was the first organization to start the studio system in India. A record number of 150 films have been produced under its banner over a span of 25 years. Eminent maestros of Indian cinema began their film careers at this legendary studio, including directors Pramathesh Barua and Bimal Roy, cinematographer Nitin Bose, music directors Pankaj Mullick and R.C. SYNOPSIS

He finds a job in a huge department store. The film chronicles the exploitation of young boys and girls who work for huge business houses. Treated as slaves, exploited beyond their energy levels and physical tolerance, they have no option but to continue working under such miserable conditions. But the spirited Mahesh and his girlfriend quit their jobs and find a way to survive, despite a major tragedy coming their way.

2010 | Malayalam | 120 min

SYNOPSIS

1968. Kerala is caught in the throes of the radical leftist Naxalite movement. Kochubaby, a 13-year-old boy living in a remote hillside village, is facing problems of his own – he has lost his vision. He finds work in a candle-making factory run by a local priest. He falls in love with Mary, also blind, marries her, and they have a daughter. Mary gets killed in a road accident. Though the demise of his wife leaves Kochubaby shattered, he comes back with renewed vigour to live for his daughter's sake. When she becomes an adolescent, she finds that she too is gradually losing her eyesight. Kochubaby resolves never to let his daughter succumb to the handicap.

From organizing film clubs and writing short stories while in school, Premlal began writing columns in dailies and different magazines on socio-economic issues after completing his education. SYNOPSIS

A psycho-sensual drama heavily charged with primal energy, *Elektra* is a journey into the bruised familial bonds of an aristocratic household in Kerala.

Elektra, devoted to her father Abraham, and enraged by her mother Diana's adulterous relationship in his absence, lives in a world torn between passion and fixation. On the night of his arrival from Jaffna, Abraham is found dead under mysterious circumstances. Elektra's rage against, and her brother Edwin's love for, their mother sparks a series of deaths and acts of vengeance. Marooned in guilt and penitence, Edwin sees his obsessive love transferred to Elektra, who has to face the worst.

SYNOPSIS

Inspired by a television story about former Indian President APJ Abdul Kalam's impoverished childhood, Chotu finds himself saying, "I am Kalam" when asked his name. 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
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JHING CHIK JHING

SYNOPSIS

Set in central Maharashtra, the film tells the story of a mischievous and inquisitive boy, Shyam, whose idyllic world is in contrast to his family's struggle. The family earns its meagre living by growing cotton. Their idyllic life is thrown asunder as Shyam learns about his family's reeling debt and father's fading hopes of getting their farmland out of mortgage.

Overcoming the initial dejection, Shyam takes it upon himself to save his family. He hits upon a scheme – a sack race that carries a prize of Rs 10,000. Aided by his siblings, he starts practising for the race of his life.

A postgraduate in linguistics, Nitin Nandan worked widely in television as a director, researcher and scriptwriter before making his debut as a feature filmmaker with *Jhing Chik Jhing*.

JUST ANOTHER LOVE STORY

2010 | English | 129 min

SYNOPSIS

Chapal Bhaduri, who is over 70 years old, was once famous for the feminine lead roles he played. He is essentially a woman trapped in a man's body. He lives a forsaken life, surviving on memories of his past until he meets Abhiroop Sen, an openly gay filmmaker who lures him with big money to reveal his tragic story in great detail for a documentary.

Media wrath, homophobia, emotional conflicts, and attractions ensue in the lives of the characters, while they come across their similar complexities, divided loyalties and bonds of sisterhood with a lover's suffering 'legitimate' wife. The conflicts force Abhiroop to question his fake liberation, and face his essential solitude as a marginal being in society.

Kolkata-born Kaushik Ganguly spent eight years as a teacher and freelance scriptwriter before turning a director in the year 1995 with the television series *Raahat*. SYNOPSIS

Karthika is the daughter of an upper-caste ruler of a land in which lower-caste people are oppressed by untouchability. Kannan is the nephew of the Chief of Rituals, entitled and bound to protect tradition and rituals. Kannan and Karthika fall in love despite their caste differences. As a consequence, Kannan is executed by the ruler and Karthika goes missing. The rituals and 'Theyyam' (an ancient form of worship) of the Vannan community are banned in the land. Twenty-five years later, a young man resembling Kannan, whose name is Jayadevan appears in the land. He becomes instrumental in undoing the communal tension and reintroducing the banned 'Theyyam' performances in the area.

DIRECTOR'S PROFILE

Kaalchilambu is MT Annoor's first film as an independent director. He has had an illustrious career in drama spanning over 20 years and has directed and acted in several plays in Malayalam.
