WELCOME TO VIEWING ROOM AT NFDC FILM BAZAAR 2024

The Viewing Room (VR) was introduced in the 2011 edition of NFDC Film Bazaar. The aim of the Viewing Room is to present Indian and South Asian films that are recently completed or in the final stages of editing and post production to buyers, film programmers, distributors, world sales agents and investors attending Film Bazaar. It uses software that has been exclusively designed for this purpose.

The Viewing Room is a highly restricted zone, where the first level of filter is via NFDC granting access to a delegate based on their Market Guide profile that should clearly be aligned to the function of a 'Buyer' i.e. someone who is attending the Film Bazaar with the intention of sourcing content for their company, festival, platform etc. These delegates are given 'VR Access' indicated by a Play Button Icon (▶) on their badge. We ensure that the filmmaker is always comfortable and confident about presenting their films which are usually in a stage of progress to a professional film market.

Delegates with 'VR Access' can watch the films or film excerpts on the VR Software by using pre-designed filters to sort films by criteria of length, premiere status, completion status etc. They can directly contact the director or producer of the film through this software.

This VR catalogue also contains the details of all the films playing in the Viewing Room software this year. A delegate can choose which film to watch on the software by shortlisting titles from this catalogue.

A delegate without 'VR access' can also reach out to filmmakers via information given in this catalogue. This catalogue will be available on the NFDC Film Bazaar website in the Archive section post Film Bazaar.

A total of 205 films will be presented in the Viewing Room this year, including a section on Restored Classics.

The films presented are seeking finishing funds, world sales, distribution partners and selection in film festivals. This catalogue contains information on these films divided into five main categories –

Film Bazaar Recommends (FBR) - Features, Mid-Length and Shorts

Film Bazaar Recommends - Features, Film Bazaar Recommends Mid-Length and Film Bazaar Recommends - Shorts, as the names suggest, is a curated section of films selected from the total feature films, mid-length film and short film submissions to Viewing Room. FBR films in Viewing Room are looking for either or all of the three main criteria i.e. Finishing Funds, Distribution & Sales and Film Festivals. These films are absolutely new; most are works in progress, unreleased and are yet to have their world premiere at any film festival. Most of the films in this section are having their first market screening at this Film Bazaar. The Film Bazaar Recommends (FBR) list curates and highlights 27 projects consisting of 19 feature films, 3 mid-length films, 2 short films and 3 restored classics out of the entire mix. The FBR section is curated by Mrs. Shona Urvashi, Consultant Curator, Film Bazaar 2024.

The Film Pitches of the directors and producers of these films are presented at Knowledge Series at the 'FBR Pitch'.

Film Library (FL)

All submissions to the Viewing Room other than the FBR Films are showcased in a section called Film Library (FL), which includes both Fiction and Documentary Films. This year we have 178 films in the Film Library Section, films including a curated list of Restored classics also.

We hope you return to this catalogue at different times across the year to get in touch with various filmmakers to either invest in their films or source films for your festival, market, company or platform. Happy Viewing!

Curator Profile

Shona Urvashi is an accomplished director, writer, and entrepreneur with significant experience in the Indian film industry. Her directorial ventures include critically acclaimed films like *Chupke Se* (2003) and *Saas Bahu Aur Sensex* (2008), demonstrating her keen understanding of complex narratives and audience engagement. As the founder of PLA Entertainment, she has been instrumental in restoring and digitizing classic Bollywood films for international distribution, showcasing her commitment to preserving cinematic heritage.

Her expertise has been internationally recognized with the prestigious *Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters award* from France, acknowledging her role in fostering cross-cultural cinema. Her discerning eye for talent shines through in her role as a curator for Film Bazaar Recommends (FBR), where she handpicked 21 standout films from a pool of 205 submissions this year.

Mitu Bhowmick Lange AM is an award-winning Australian-Indian film distributor, festival director and producer, known for bringing Indian subcontinent cinema to global audiences. She is the director and founder of Mind Blowing Films Group (MBF), the primary distributor of Indian films across Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, and Papua New Guinea. Mitu is the festival director of Indian Film Festival of Melbourne (principal partner Victoria State Government) and Indian Film Festival of Sydney, showcasing the finest Indian subcontinent cinema in Australia. Mitu serves on the VicScreen board and the board of the Centre for Australia-India Relations. Mitu is also a seasoned producer with a portfolio of award-winning films and documentaries. Her latest feature film, *My Melbourne* (2024), presented by VicScreen and Screen Australia, celebrates diversity through a unique anthology format. Mitu has built a vibrant community of cinema lovers, creating a meaningful cultural bridge through film. Mitu helped us curate the most deserving 6 Work-in-Progress projects for WIP lab, which also compose the curated section that is Film Bazaar Recommends.

New Theatres' classic celebration of Mithila's King Shiva Singha's (Bannerjee/Kapoor) love for his wife while chronicling the influence of the pacifist court poet Bidyapati (Sanyal). Invited to the royal court by the king, Bidyapati arrives with his faithful follower Anuradha (Kanan Devi). Queen Laxmi (Chhaya Devi) falls in love with the poet, much to the distress of the king. The king falls ill and starts neglecting his royal duties until Anuradha persuades him that true love does not need reciprocation. The queen, equally distressed by her divided loyalties, contemplates suicide, encouraged by the prime minister who is worried by the nefarious impact of Bidyapati's poetry on the king. Both the king and queen sacrifice their lives before the statue of the god Vishnu who appears to weep at the tragedy. Kanan Devi's unusually intense performance dominates the film, aided by a fast-moving script that broke with the convention of the static, frontal camera style of Indian film-devotionals (cf. the move from the opening Dhol celebrations to the miracle scenes and the witches' dance, as well as the complicated climactic sequence). The sustained use of filmic close-ups allows Bidyapati's poetry to take on an autonomous motivational function in the plot, almost as though his art, rather than he himself, is the story's true protagonist.

After P.V. Rao's 1937 film, this is the 2nd Tamil and the first Telugu version of Saratchandra's oft-filmed novel about unrequited love. Nageshwara Rao is the weak hero Devadas and Savitri is his tragic beloved Paro while Lalitha takes the role of the golden-hearted prostitute Chandramukhi. The hit film was shot mostly at the Narasu Studios in Madras. The 11 songs (in both languages) of Subburaman's last film are regarded as among his best and most popular works, while Narayana Kavi's lyrics enhanced the popularity of the Tamil songs, one of them later providing the title for a Kamal Hasan film, *Vazhve Mayam* (1982), an update of the Devdas plot.

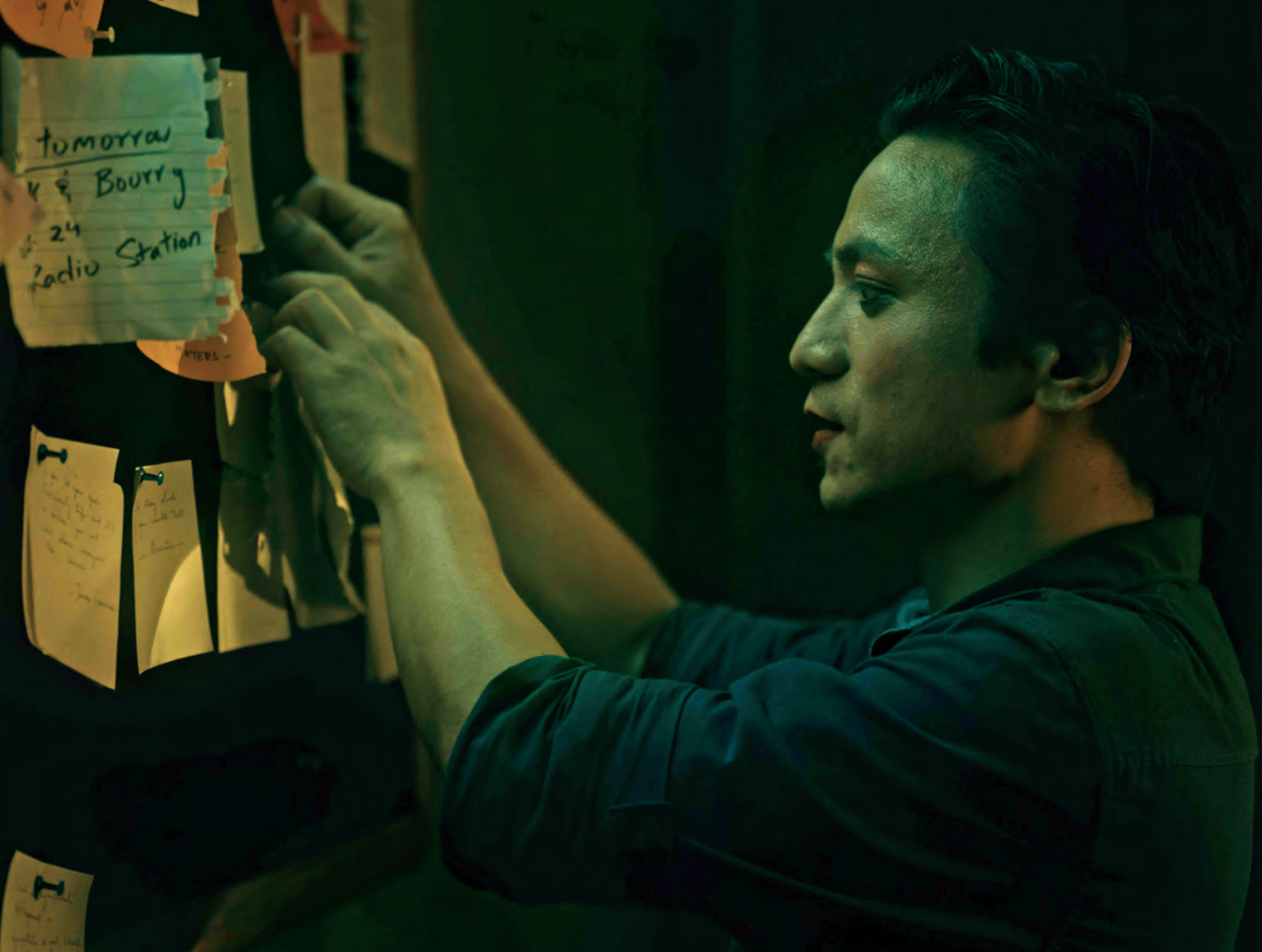

Driven by the desire to prevent her family from living a listless life, Bishnu takes it upon herself to encourage them to be more independent. She motivates her grandmother to perform her own tasks, urges Junu to seek employment, and takes charge of male responsibilities like dealing with tenants, ordering helpers and driving Junu to the hospital. In a housefull of women, Bishnu assumes the role of a figurative male. She also begins a relationship with Gyan, a local architect, hoping to construct a homestay together. However, things take a sudden change, when a backdoor is found open and a glass window is broken. Sawney suspects that Bishnu's abrupt outbursts have disturbed the delicate equilibrium that she had worked hard to maintain for peaceful coexistence in the village. Complicating matters, Bishnu realises that Gyan is gradually assuming her responsibilities, relegating her to a conventional female role.

Major Marathi melodrama based on one of the most influential 20th C. Marathi novels (1935), a fictionalised account of the childhood years of Sane Guruji (1899-1950). A nationalist influenced by Vinoba Bhave and esp. Gandhi, he was imprisoned repeatedly for his work among the peasantry and participation in the Quit India agitations. His book Shyamchi Aai, written in jail, has 45 episodes in which Shyam, a youth living in poverty in Konkan, recalls the teachings of his mother. The film incorporates the heavy nationalist symbolism associated with the mother (Vanamala), a devoutly religious person with an earthy philosophy, as well as the sentimental depiction of her relationship with her son (Vaze). Despite its emphasis on a ruralist realism, the characters remain exemplary and (surprisingly for Atre) humourless stereotypes. The film, like the book, relies on flashbacks as Sane Guruji (D. Joshi) tells the stories in homage to a person to whom he owes everything. Episodes showing the young Shyam's maturation culminate in the mother's death. The hit film has remained a generic landmark in Marathi melodrama, esp. for Vanamala's maternal prototype. The book has been analysed by Shanta Gokhale (1990).

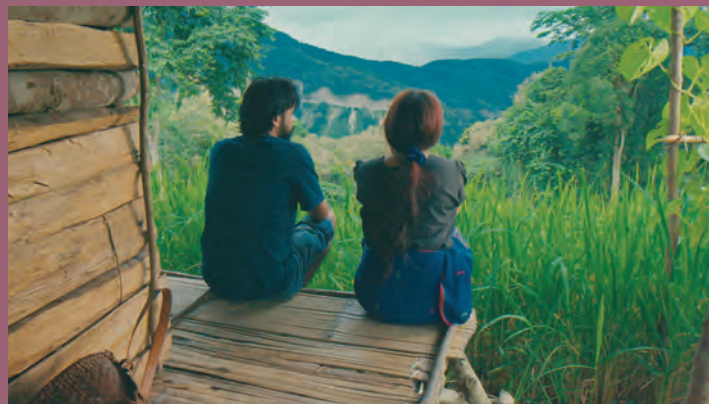

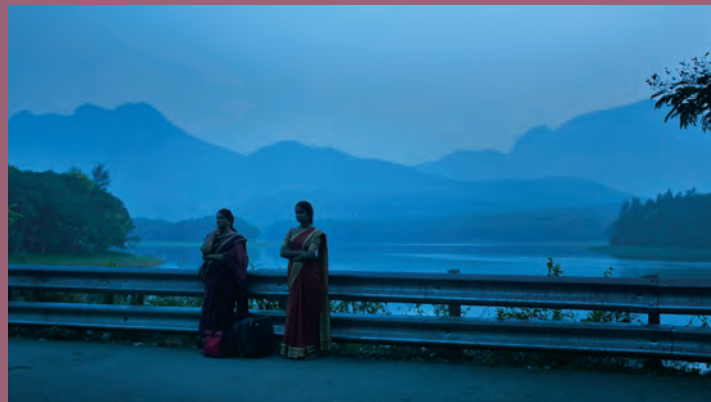

He flees in fear, and unwittingly finds himself strung to a collective consciousness that propagates communal hatred under the guise of religion. Saved from submission, he's transported to the Old man's past at an abandoned mansion he calls home. For the first time, he speaks of his fears and their origin at the profanity-screaming Bharani festival. The old man makes it apparent that his belief was riddled with thoughts so deeply intrusive that he couldn't differentiate them from reality, forcing him to head home, where he finds that his thoughts haven't manifested themselves into the reality he fears.

Rumours abound of the ghost of a woman raped and killed by Kumar's ancestor. Kumar falls for the local belle Radha (Rehman) and meets a gallery of dubious characters: an ex-con servant, a bearded doctor and a man on crutches who turns out to be a disguised policeman. The first half of the film builds up the suspense, mostly using the soundtrack according to generic conventions. The plot then becomes a whodunit until the murderer is revealed: Radha's guardian (M. Krishna), the father of the woman killed 20 years ago. Waheeda's seduction number, associating her with the ghost, is the classic Kahin deep jale kahin dil (sung by Lata Mangeshkar).

A propaganda film dedicated to Nehru and trading on the resurgence of nationalist sentiment in the wake of the India-China war of 1962 which provides the film's setting. The war had led to a sobering awareness of India's military capability and contributed to major schisms about Nehruite notions of non-alignment while accelerating the split in the CPI between Moscow-and Beijing-aligned groups. Made by former Marxists Anand, Sahni et al., the film's main plot concerns a small platoon of Indian soldiers presumed dead but rescued by Kashmiri gypsies and by Capt. Bahadur Singh (Dharmendra) and his tribal girlfriend (Rajvansh) who die holding the Chinese at bay while their comrades retreat to safety. Rhetorical highlights including the platoon commander (Sahni) excoriating Mao's Little Red Book which a soldier spears with a bayonet; the commanding officer (Jayant) denouncing the Chinese to documentary footage of Zhou En-Lai landing in Delhi and being given a guard of honour; Kaifi Azmi's song Kar chale hum fida jaan-o-tan saathiyon (sung by Mohammed Rafi) cut to more documentary shots of Nehru addressing the troops and of the Republic Day parade. Shot on location on the Ladakh border, the film had one other song hit, the soldiers' qawali Ho ke majboor mujhe usne bulaya hoga (sung by Mohammed Rafi, Bhupendra, Talat Mahmood, Manna Dey and a chorus).
